Until the final net cash dividend amount is determined, the underlying price for RIO1/2RIO1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{RIO1} = \text{RIO} + 2.4381$$

DELAYED SETTLEMENT

The RIO component of the RIO1/2RIO1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the RIO1/2RIO1 deliverable until exact cash amount is determined. Upon determination of the exact cash amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
